The McCalman Hall on the right-hand side of the entrance hall is where we play bridge. Other club sections such as table tennis, tennis coaching and indoor bowls make use of this room on a

In addition, you pay an extra levy of, at present, £24 per annum to join the S10 Bridge Club & 50p per week table fee (when you play) to cover the cost of tea/coffee. Visitors may attend 3 times at a cost of £2 per night before deciding whether or not to join. (There is at present a 25% reduction on the total £56 per annum for the first year of joining & new members also get their visitors fees reimbursed).

The members are a friendly bunch and new players are very welcome. Inexperienced players need not feel intimidated and it is not essential to come with a partner. Two members act as stewards in turn each week and prepare tea/coffee for us and also are available as partners when needed.
